This funding will be used to

- Increase student achievement in English A-C results to 80% or above for P-12.
- Lift NAPLAN in Year 3 Reading to Mean Scale Score of (MSS) 405 or above.
- Lift NAPLAN in Year 9 Writing to MSS of 490 or above.

Our initiatives include

- Using a feedback cycle of five minute systemic observation and ten minute neutral observation of teaching, every fortnight focussed on Reading and Writing.
- Further developing our P-12 Curriculum Framework with a focus on Reading and Writing.
- Using visual curriculum in the classroom to explicitly track student progress through the Australian Curriculum.
- Driving increased individual support and tracking of student learning in the classroom and achievement on an A-E 50 point scale in Mathematic, English, Science and Humanities and Social Sciences (HASS)

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Providing professional development offline for teachers | \$30,009 |
| • Resourcing to support the reading and writing improvement | \$22,500 |
| • Providing individual student support through the curriculum in the classroom | \$10,500 |
| • Providing individual teacher support developing expertise in reading and writing | \$50,000 |
